

Church Wall Horse Tethering Rings

Some 60-plus years ago, there were iron rings, to which horses were tethered, set at intervals in the church wall. It's doubtful if anyone alive today can remember horses being tethered and very few who might recall the rings. These 2011 pictures, clearly showing remnants of iron in the wall, are probably all that remains of them.



And here's the real thing, although not from the church wall but from the wall of what used to be the vicarage opposite. When the wall was being rebuilt this original ring was salvaged and set in the new wall.
